Corps are locally-based organizations that provide young adults and veterans the opportunity to serve our country, advance their education and obtain in-demand job skills. During defined terms of service in crews or individual placement positions, Corps participants – or “Corpsmembers” – gain work experience by performing important conservation, recreation, infrastructure, disaster response, and community development projects. In exchange for their service, Corpsmembers receive a stipend and often earn an education award or scholarship. Corps annually enroll over 25,000 youth and veterans across all 50 states, DC, and the U.S. territories.
