- Public Land Corps Cooperative Agreements: The Corps Network holds cooperative agreements that Corps can use to engage in fee-for-service contracts with federal partners, including the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, National Park Service, and U.S. Forest Service.  The Corps Coop: The Corps Coop is a group purchasing organization that utilizes the collective purchasing power of our members to negotiate discounted prices for goods and services. The Corps Coop has formal agreements with more than a dozen national vendors, ranging from car rental and hotel chains to companies offering health and workers' compensation insurance, office supplies, tools, and more.
