The Corpsmember of the Year Award honors exceptional young adults from our member Service and Conservation Corps.





Acoma Pueblo Water Delivery (NM) Ancestral Lands Conservation Corps 2023 Project of the Year

When Acoma Pueblo suffered a major water infrastructure failure, Corpsmembers helped deliver potable water and other critical supplies to community members in need, making visits to dozens of homes every day. The Corps stepped up to help fill gaps in the emergency response efforts.

Corpsmembers helped a local organization remove overgrowth and complete restoration work at this 1800s African American cemetery, helping uncover long-hidden grave markers and giving families a piece of their history back.
