

Student Loan Forgiveness

Student loan debt varies state by state. Most states have student loan forgiveness programs that may offer relief for graduates trying to pay off their debt.

Student debt is what's owned when a borrower uses a federal or private loan to cover the costs of higher education. Student loan forgiveness helps borrowers not have to repay part of or all of their federal student loan debts.

- Only federal direct loans qualify for loan forgiveness.
 - o Private loans are not covered.
- Student loan forgiveness can be earned by working in public service.
- Eligibility requirements vary based with the type of loan.
