Urban Wood Career Pathway
Conservation Corps of Long Beach (CCLB)
With a \$1 million CAL FIRE grant, CCLB partnered
with the City of Long Beach to put Corpsmembers

to work removing 1,000 dead or dying trees and replacing them with 2,000 healthy trees.

This program also included an urban lumber salvage apprenticeship program.



Sound to Summit *Northwest Youth Corps*

This program engages teens from urban communities in the South Puget Sound to serve locally, as well as at national parks like Mt. Rainier and Olympic. S2S combines urban and backcountry programming, introducing new communities to our public lands and advancing environmental justice.



Bia Ogwa *Utah Conservation Corps*

In collaboration with the Northwestern Band of the Shoshone Nation, the Corps is conducting long-term restoration projects along Bia Ogwa (Bear River), the site of one the worst indigenous massacres in US history. This project aims to increase climate resiliency and restore the habitat to a state similar to when it was inhabited by the Shoshone Tribe.
