Corps are local organizations that engage young adults (generally ages 16 - 30) and veterans (up to age 35) in service projects that address conservation and community needs. Through a term of service that could last from a few months to a year, Corps participants - or "Corpsmembers" gain work experience and develop in-demand skills. Corpsmembers are compensated and often receive an education award or scholarship upon completing their service. Additionally, Corps provide participants educational programming, mentoring, and access to career and personal counseling. Learn more
