The Texas Conservation Corps of American YouthWorks (TXCC), partnering with the US Forest Service Southern Region, has positions available offering extensive training and certifications in wildland firefighting and natural resource management. Crews of 3-5 AmeriCorps members will spend their season completing a variety of fire response activities, prescribed burns, conservation projects, and cyclical maintenance objectives on US Forest Service National Forests and Grasslands of Texas sites. Ability to pass the **Arduous Work Capacity Pack test** (walk 3 miles in 45 minutes carrying 45 lbs) is required to complete the program.
