Founded in May of 1998, we provide support to the Town of Phillipsburg & Warren County providing hundreds of youth the opportunity to earn their High School Equivalency (HSE) while providing a valuable service to their community.

We're looking for a Team Leader to manage our NJ Youth Corp s/Delaware River Climate Corps! This position is an integral member of our Youth Corps family, with the primary responsibility of recruiting, mentoring and supervising our Corpsmember base for the NJ Youth Corps/Delaware River Climate Corps program. The Team Leader also works closely with crew members and other staff members to ensure our young adults' personal & professional growth and development. This requires strong communication and interpersonal skills, strong organization, and attention to detail. The right person for this position will be also solution-oriented with a constructive and collaborative approach.

Physical Requirements: Periodic overnight travel and non-traditional work hours, inclusive of weekend and evening hours. To successfully perform essential functions the Team Leader is required to sit, stand, walk, speak and hear. The candidate may be required to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl on an infrequent basis. He/she must be able to operate office equipment, telephone, and computer, and may be required to lift up to 50 pounds unassisted. The ability to drive an organizational vehicle (15 passenger van) is also required.
